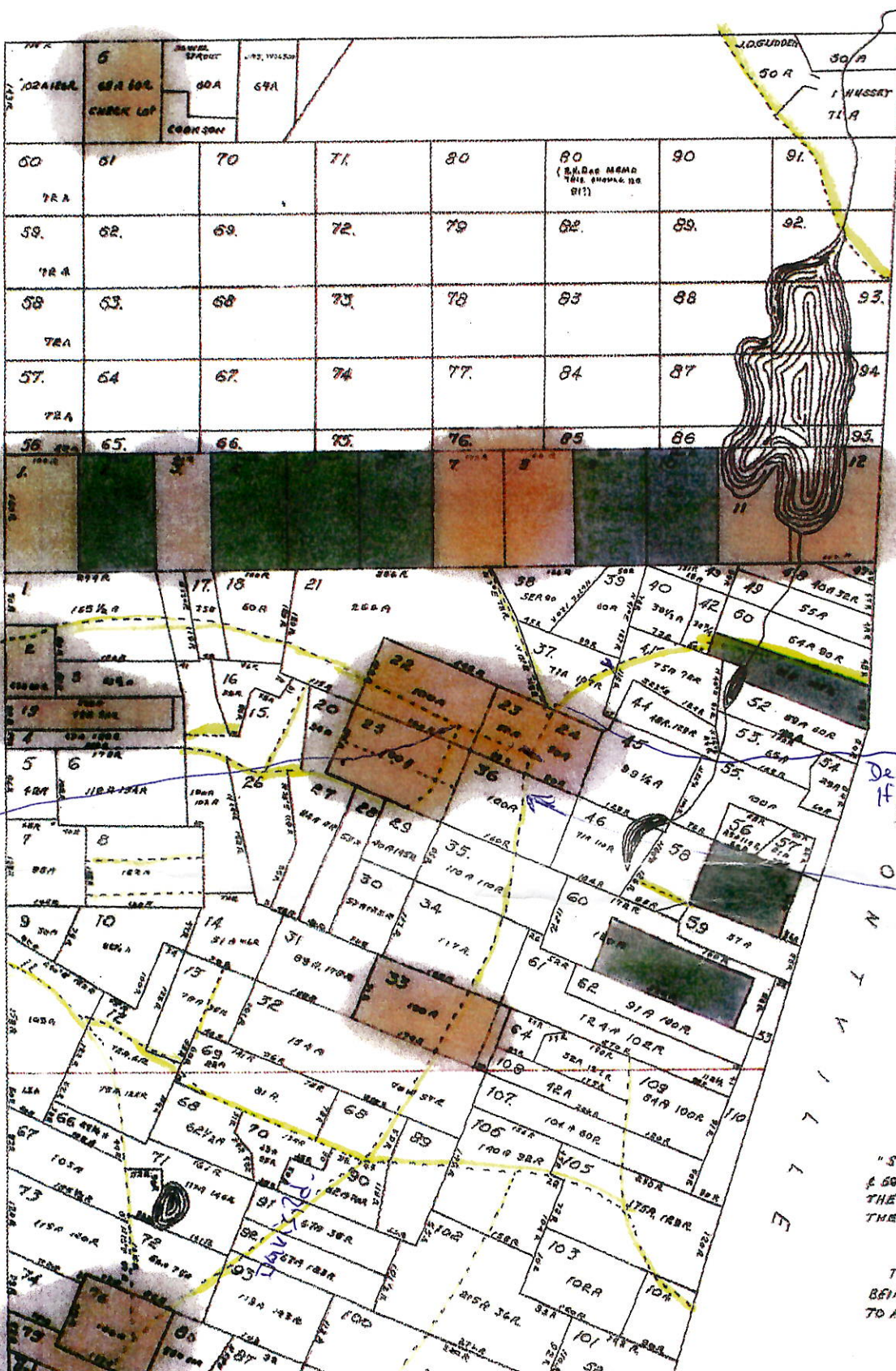


TOWN OF FREEDOM MAINE
