ANNUAL REPORT

- Art. 34. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the following roads as town ways now and forever but opened as public ways:
 - (a) From Greeley's Corner to Improved road under Beaver Hill.
 - (b) From Sibley Four Corners, so called, to the R. Smith place.
 - (c) From Arthur Aldrich place, south west, to Palermo and Freedom State Aid road.
 - (d) From George Wagner's old place, so-called, South to Palermo town line.
 - (e) From O. B. Ward's to discontinued road over Beaver Hill.
- Art. 35. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$500.00 for power steering for F.W.D. Truck.
- Art. 36. To transact any other business that may legally be brought before said meeting.
- Art. 37. Motion to adjourn.

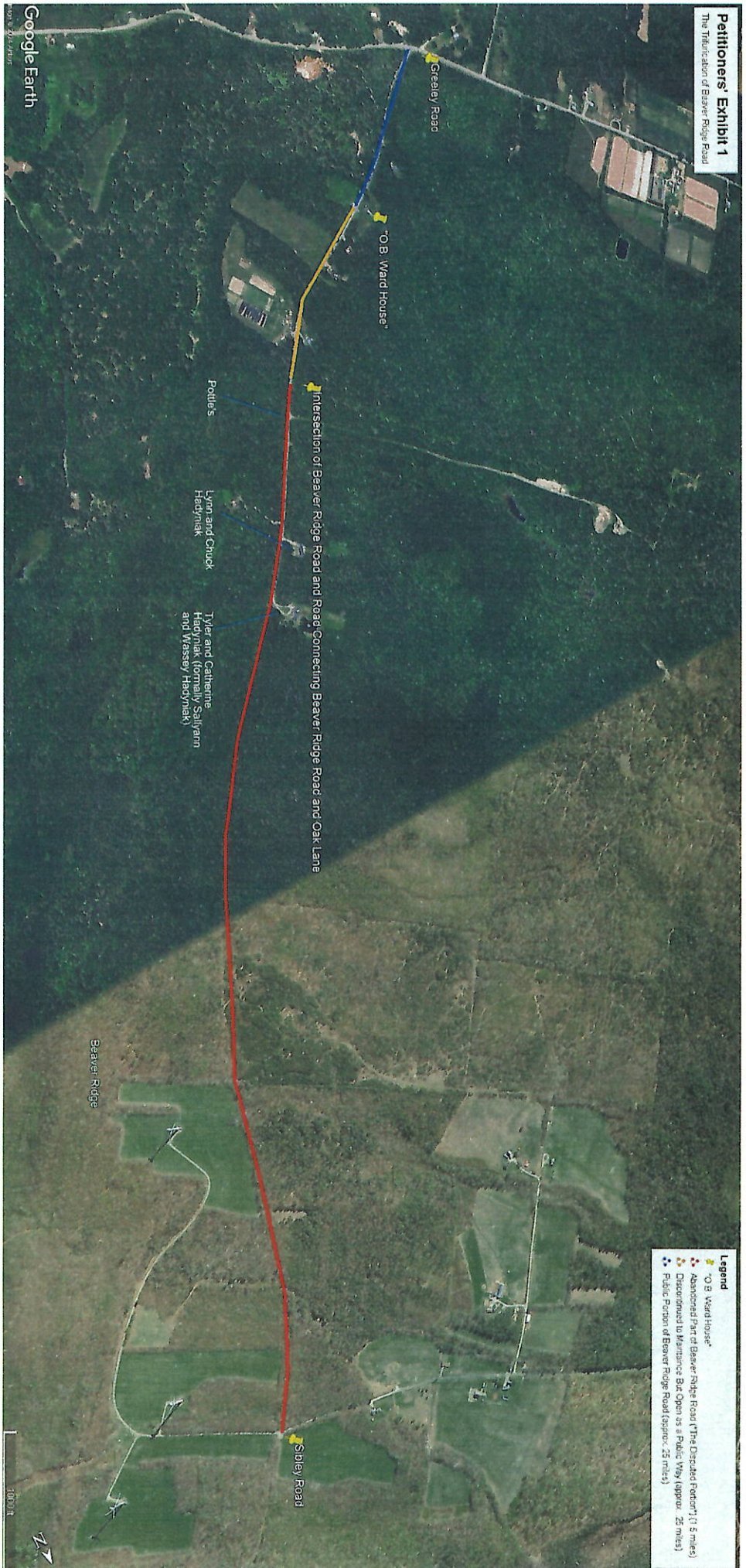
