



Freedom Solid Waste Policy

Weekly Trash Pickup:

All household trash will be picked up every Thursday. The only exception to this is when Thursday is a national holiday such as Thanksgiving. No trash will be picked up on a holiday that falls on a Thursday. In those instances trash will be picked up on Friday.

Trash should be set at curbside by 7 AM each Thursday to ensure the trash is out when the truck goes by. If the trash is set out after the truck has gone by, all trash must be brought back into the house or garage and set back out again the following week.

All bags must weigh less than 40 pounds.

All bags must have one trash sticker

No bags larger than 55 gallons

All trash bags that are placed in trash cans or any other type of container still need trash stickers with no exception. If more than one bag has been placed separately in a container, and not in a larger bag, then each bag requires a trash sticker.

All sharp objects such as needles or razor blades must be placed in a glass or metal container that cannot be punctured.

Trash bags should be placed roadside in a timely manner. Old bags that are heavy, wet or with rotting material will NOT be picked up.

Bags containing rotting or fecal material is a biohazard and will NOT be picked up.

Spring Clean Up

No less than 2 weeks in May or early June will be dedicated to Spring Clean Up. The exact dates will be announced by the end of April with a mailing going out to all residents explaining what can and what cannot be picked up. The mailing will also list certain dates that specific items, such as tires, mattresses, or metal will be picked up.

During Spring Clean Up, normal household trash will be picked up on Thursdays as usual.
