We invite you to join the 2024 Library Pass Program at Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens!

The mission of Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens is to inspire meaningful connections among people, plants, and nature through horticulture, education, and research. The Library Pass Program is designed to strengthen connections between the Gardens and our local communities.

The following is a brief description of the Library Pass Program:

- For each day during the May-October season, the town office can schedule a free visit for members of the Library.
- The Library Pass is good for 1 Family per day.
 - o Family = 1 or 2 adults + their children/grandchildren under the age of 18.
 - O Library Passes are limited to 1 Adult + 5 Children or 2 Adults + 10 Children.
- When a resident requests a pass to visit the Gardens, the town office will check their own records for available dates and can book any day not already held by our residents.
- The town office then logs on the Gardens website www.mainegardens.org and reserves (\$0) Library Program Adult or Child tickets (one for each adult and one for each child) for the chosen date. The town office then prints the tickets for their members to present for admission at the Gardens. The town office may alternatively forward the digital tickets to the patron for printing or showing on a phone screen.
- Library Pass Program is for admission only during the Garden season (May–Oct) and does not include Gardens Aglow. Library Pass Program is not a membership and does not include member discounts and members-only events.

We hope that you are able to schedule a day at the gardens for you and your family. Free Library passes are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
